# Consistency of learning during new build works

## THE BRIEF

With a new school under construction, Kingswood Parks Primary needed a temporary solution that students could settle into quickly, with disruption kept to a minimum. Due to our reputation for our high-quality interim solutions and speed of delivery, we were appointed to tackle their need for additional space.

## THE SOLUTION

Three temporary teaching blocks, comprising a total of five classrooms were arranged on site to allow easy access for pupils, whose safety was paramount during new building works. A mix of 12.2m and 9.6m modules created a spacious learning environment, alongside stores, cloakrooms and toilets. Disabled access and toilet facilities were also provided.

Installed on site within a week, the facility was in use by pupils within a few days of completion.

## THE CHALLENGES

- As an active school site, pupil safety was paramount
- To minimise disruption, we worked closely with school leaders to ensure our programme of works fit with term times
- Our temporary accommodation needed to reflect the quality learning space of the new school to keep children and parents engaged.
